**Dr. Jimmy's Sermon Series from
the Acts of the Apostles**

Day 50 of the Great 50 Days of Eastertide

Pentecost Day, which always occurs on a Sunday and 50 days after Easter Day, marks the Birthday of the Church and the empowerment of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church. It is one of at least three High and Holy Days (or it should be) in the Church, along with Easter Day and Christmas Day. The liturgical colors for the day are red and white. Wear something red this Lord's Day.
